Community Outreach



Help Me Grow used virtual platforms to host **47** community outreach events – providing opportunities for families to learn skills related to the five protective factors. **38,000** Vermont families were reached.

Developmental Screening



9,000 children are currently enrolled in childcare programs that have received *Help Me Grow* training, so **50%** of preschoolers are better prepared to succeed as they enter kindergarten.

Resource Hub



- Staff at the resource hub received
 3,298 incoming calls and referrals. Staff provided 4,277 referrals.
- Referrals for perinatal mood and anxiety disorders (PMADs) increased after <u>Support Delivered</u> launched in 2020. *Help Me Grow* worked with 57 individuals and provided 230 referrals.

Goals for 2022

- Support child wellbeing by offering events for Vermont families that educate and nurture child development.
- Strengthen the resource hub database to include more mental health services.
- Expand use of Help Me Grow's ASQ Online platform to ensure earlier identification of developmental concerns and increase kindergarten readiness.
